## Seminar 12: Podcast Assignment Sheet

For this Skill Assessment, you will be <u>writing</u> and <u>recording</u> a podcast that sounds like natural speech but is written using appropriate punctuation and grammar tools to achieve your natural, authentic voice.



A **podcast** is a digital audio file that is generally made available to the public. Podcasts can be informa@ve (like a news story), opinionated (like an editorial), and narra@ve (like a story). Your podcast should show an understanding of the components of voice that we learned in Seminar: atu de, tone, and personal style.
